1 Corporation, Consolidated Freightways Corporation of Delaware, Redwood Systems, Inc.,
2 Leland James Service Corporation, CF Airfreight Corporation and CF MovesU.com
3 Incorporated, debtors and debtors-in-possession herein (collectively, the "Debtors"), for an Order
4 Authorizing (I) Continued Use Of Existing Business Forms And Records; (II) Maintenance Of
5 Existing Corporate Bank Accounts And Cash Management System; And (III) Continued Use Of
6 Existing Investment Policy. Appearances were made as noted in the record of the hearing on the
7 Motion.

9 The Court having considered the Motion, the arguments and evidence proffered at
10 the initial hearing on the Motion and at the Continued Hearing, and the record in these cases,
11 having entered the Order Continuing Hearing with Respect to Motion for Order Authorizing (I)
12 Continued Use of Existing Business Forms and Records; (II) Maintenance of Existing Corporate
13 Bank Accounts and Cash Management System; and (III) Continued Use of Existing Investment
14 Policy, and finding that adequate notice of the Motion was given and that there is good cause to
15 grant the Motion; it is hereby

16 **ORDERED THAT** the Motion shall be and hereby is granted to the extent set
17 forth below; and it is further

18 **ORDERED THAT** the Debtors are authorized to continue to use their existing
19 business forms and records and to maintain their existing corporate bank accounts and cash
20 management system, provided, however, that, the Debtors shall have "Debtor-in-Possession" and
21 the chapter 11 case number for such Debtor printed on all checks used by the Debtors for
22 disbursement accounts opened after the commencement of these chapter 11 cases, and provided
23 further that the Debtors' are not authorized to continue to use their existing investment policy,
24 and provided further that the Debtors have not sought approval to use any securities brokerage
25 accounts and are not, by this Order, granted authority to use any such accounts.


