**FINAL ORDER (I) AUTHORIZING, BUT NOT REQUIRING, PAYMENT OF
CERTAIN PRE-PETITION WAGE CLAIMS AND REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES AND
(II) DIRECTING APPLICABLE BANKS TO HONOR CHECKS AND FUNDS
TRANSFER REQUESTS RELATING TO THE FOREGOING**

This matter came before the Court on October 1, 2002, at 10:30 a.m. in the
Courtroom of the undersigned United States Bankruptcy Judge, on the emergency motion (the

275 (1/1)

1 “Motion”) of Consolidated Freightways Corporation, Consolidated Freightways Corporation of
2 Delaware, Redwood Systems, Inc., Leland James Service Corporation, CF Airfreight
3 Corporation and CF MovesU.com Incorporated, debtors and debtors-in-possession herein
4 (collectively, the “Debtors”), and the Supplement to the Motion (the “Supplement”) for the entry
5 of an order (i) approving the Debtors’ payment of pre-petition wages, salaries, employee
6 deductions, reimbursable employee expenses and other compensation owed to their employees,
7 including related taxes and other obligations, to, or on behalf of, each of their employees,
8 including their officers (other than their Chief Executive Officer, John P. Brincko, and Chief
9 Financial Officer, Stephen S. Sokol, collectively, the “Senior Officers”), (ii) authorizing, but not
10 requiring, the Debtors to pay certain Critical Employees (as defined in the Motion) amounts in
11 excess of \$4,650, subject to a limit of \$7,500 for reimbursable employee expenses, and
12 (iii) authorizing and directing applicable banks and other financial institutions to receive,
13 process, honor and pay all checks presented for payment and to honor all funds transfer requests
14 made by the Debtors relating to the foregoing.

15 The Court, having considered the Motion, the Supplement, the Notice of Support
16 of the Motion filed by the Committee of Creditors Holding Unsecured Claims in these chapter 11
17 cases, the arguments and evidence proffered at the initial hearing and the continued hearing on
18 the Motion and the record in these cases, and the Court having entered, on September 5, 2002,
19 the Order (I) Authorizing, but Not Requiring, Payment of Certain Pre-Petition Wage Claims and
20 Reimbursable Expenses and (II) Directing Applicable Banks to Honor Checks and Funds
21 Transfer Requests Relating to the Foregoing, and the Court finding that adequate notice of the
22 Motion was given and that there is good cause to grant the Motion to the extent set forth in this
23 Order; it is hereby


24 **ORDERED THAT** the Debtors shall be and are authorized, but not required, to
25 honor, and to instruct the banks which hold the Debtors’ pre-petition payroll account to honor,
26 checks and drafts issued by the Debtors prior to commencing these chapter 11 cases on
27 September 3, 2002, to the extent such checks and drafts are in payment of pre-petition wages,
28 salaries, employee deductions, reimbursable employee expenses and other compensation, and all

1 related taxes, and pension and welfare or other benefits (collectively, the "Employee
2 Obligations") owed to, or for the benefit of, any employee, including officers and other
3 "insiders" of any of the Debtors, (as defined in 11 U.S.C. §101(31)), but not including either of
4 the Senior Officers, (the "Covered Employees") up to the amount of \$4,650 per Covered
5 Employee; and it is further

6 **ORDERED THAT** the Debtors shall be and are authorized, but not required, to
7 pay the Employees Obligations owed to the employees listed in the Schedule attached hereto as
8 Exhibit "1"(the "Critical Employees"), provided that the Debtors shall not make any payment to
9 any Critical Employee with respect to reimbursable expenses or unpaid wages and salary in
10 excess of \$7,500 in the aggregate per employee; and it is further


