20 **ORDER GRANTING (I) EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FILING OF SCHEDULES AND  
STATEMENTS AND EQUITY LIST AND (II) CERTAIN RELATED RELIEF**

21 The Motion for Order Granting (I) Extension of Time for Filing of Schedules and  
22 Statements and Equity List and (II) Certain Related Relief (the "Motion") filed by Consolidated  
23 Freightways Corporation, Consolidated Freightways Corporation of Delaware, Redwood  
24 Systems, Inc., Leland James Service Corporation, CF Airfreight Corporation, and CF  
25 MovesU.com Incorporated, debtors and debtors-in-possession herein (collectively, the  
26 "Debtors") came on for hearing on September 4, 2002, at 11:00 a.m. in the Courtroom of the  
27 undersigned United States Bankruptcy Judge. The Motion seeks entry of an order pursuant to  
28 section 105(a) of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code") and Rule 1007 of

1 the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the "Bankruptcy Rules"), granting the Debtors a 90-  
2 day extension of time, in addition to the 15-day period provided by Bankruptcy Rule 1007(c), to  
3 file (i) schedules of assets and liabilities and (ii) statements of financial affairs, current income  
4 and expenditures, executory contracts, and equity security holders (collectively, the "Schedules  
5 and Statements"). Appearances were made as noted in the record of the hearing on the Motion.


6 At the hearing, the Debtors and the Office of the United States Trustee (the  
7 "OUST") orally stipulated that the Debtors could have an extension to and including Friday,  
8 November 8, 2002 to file the Schedules and Statements, other than a schedule of asset, which  
9 would be filed and served on or before September 17, 2002.

10 The Court, having consider the Motion, the arguments and evidence proffered at  
11 the hearing on the Motion, the record in these cases, and the stipulation between the Debtors and  
12 the OUST, and the Court finding that adequate notice of the Motion was given and that good  
13 cause exists for the Motion as modified , it is hereby


14 **ORDERED THAT** the Motion is approved, and the Debtors' time to file their  
15 Schedules and Statements (except for the schedule of assets), as required by Bankruptcy Rule  
16 1007(c), is hereby extended to November 8, 2002; and it is further

17 **ORDERED THAT** the Debtors' shall file and serve a schedule of assets on or  
18 before September 17, 2002.
